1. _____ **Attend eight (8) weekly in-person workshop sessions.** In the event of a legitimate excuse for missing a workshop, I will notify Cayman Finance in advance of my absence so that alternate arrangements to attend another workshop session can be made.
2. _____ **Attend ten (10) weekly mentoring sessions.** In the event that I am unable to make a mentor session, I will contact my mentor in advance of the session to reschedule.
3. _____ **Develop a CV**
4. _____ **Participate in a mock interview.** (To be arranged by the mentor)
5. _____ **Complete a work placement application form.**
6. _____ **Complete the online pre and post programme quiz.** (pre quiz due at the start of the programme and post quiz will be sent to you after the workshops)
7. _____ **Show respect, interest and enthusiasm during workshops and mentor sessions.**

I acknowledge that failure to fulfil any of the aforementioned requirements, including but not limited to participation in workshops, mentor sessions, CV development, interviews, quizzes, and work placement, will render me ineligible to receive the KYD\$1,312.50 stipend, which is contingent upon successful completion of all components of the program.

Eligibility

The programme is open to all Caymanian students either in Year 12 of the Cayman Islands Government dual-enrolment programme, finishing Year 12 within a Private School (British School System) or finishing Grade 11 within a Private School (American School System). To be eligible for the programme, you will need to provide a letter from Immigration confirming your Caymanian status. Students must have achieved at least a GPA of 2.5 (American School System) or be predicted to receive at least three (3) C or above passes in their academic year. Your school must also be able to confirm that your attendance and behaviour is of a good standard. If you do not meet all these criteria, you will not be accepted into the programme.
